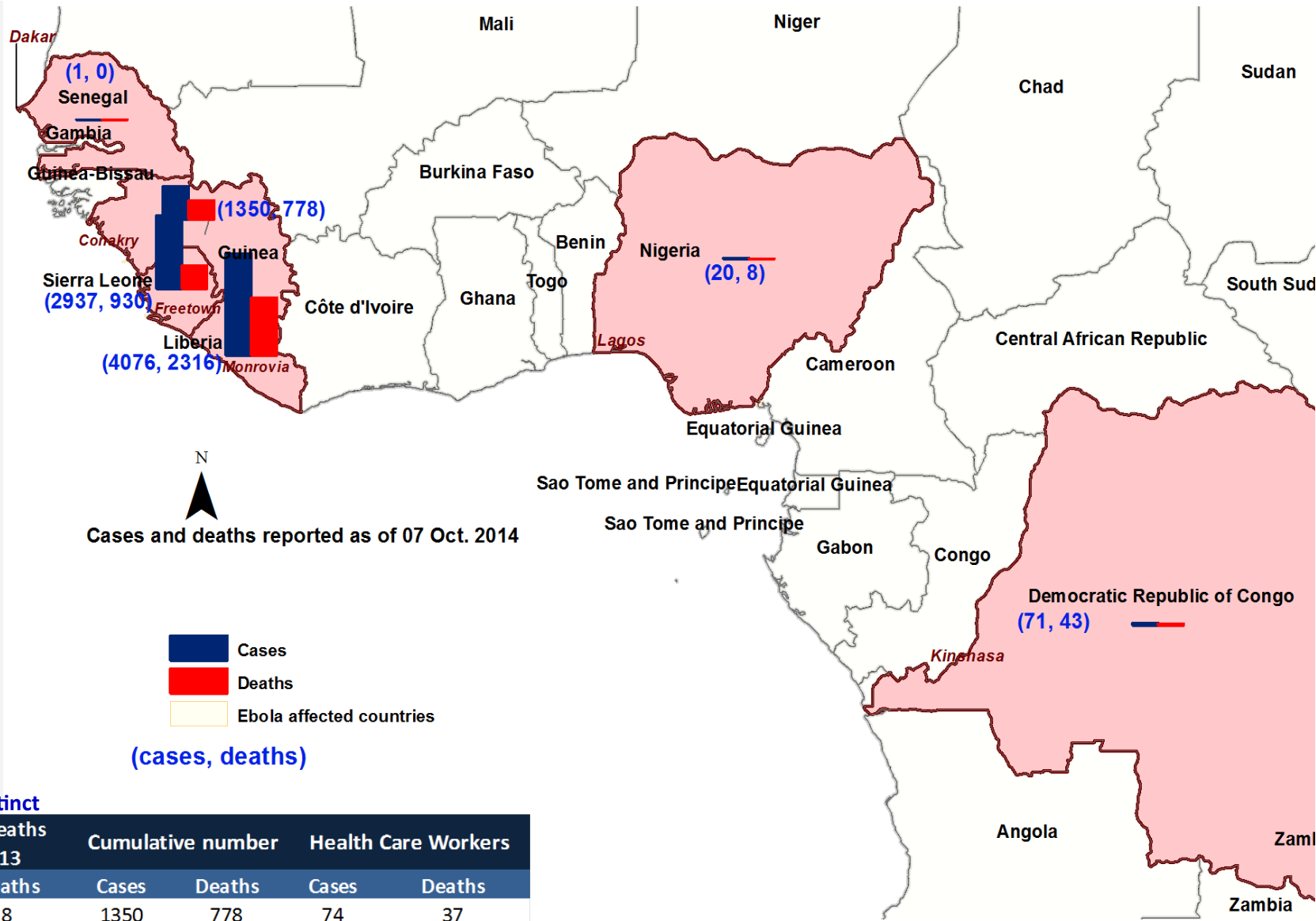


# Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) in the African region ( Situation as of 07 October 2014)

- As of 07 October 2014, a total of **8 455** EVD cases including **4 075** deaths reported from six countries (Guinea, Liberia, Sierra Leone, Nigeria, Senegal and DR Congo).
- 220** new cases including **44** death reported on 07 October 2014.
- The last confirmed cases in Senegal and Nigeria, were reported on 29 August 2014 and 08 September 2014 respectively.

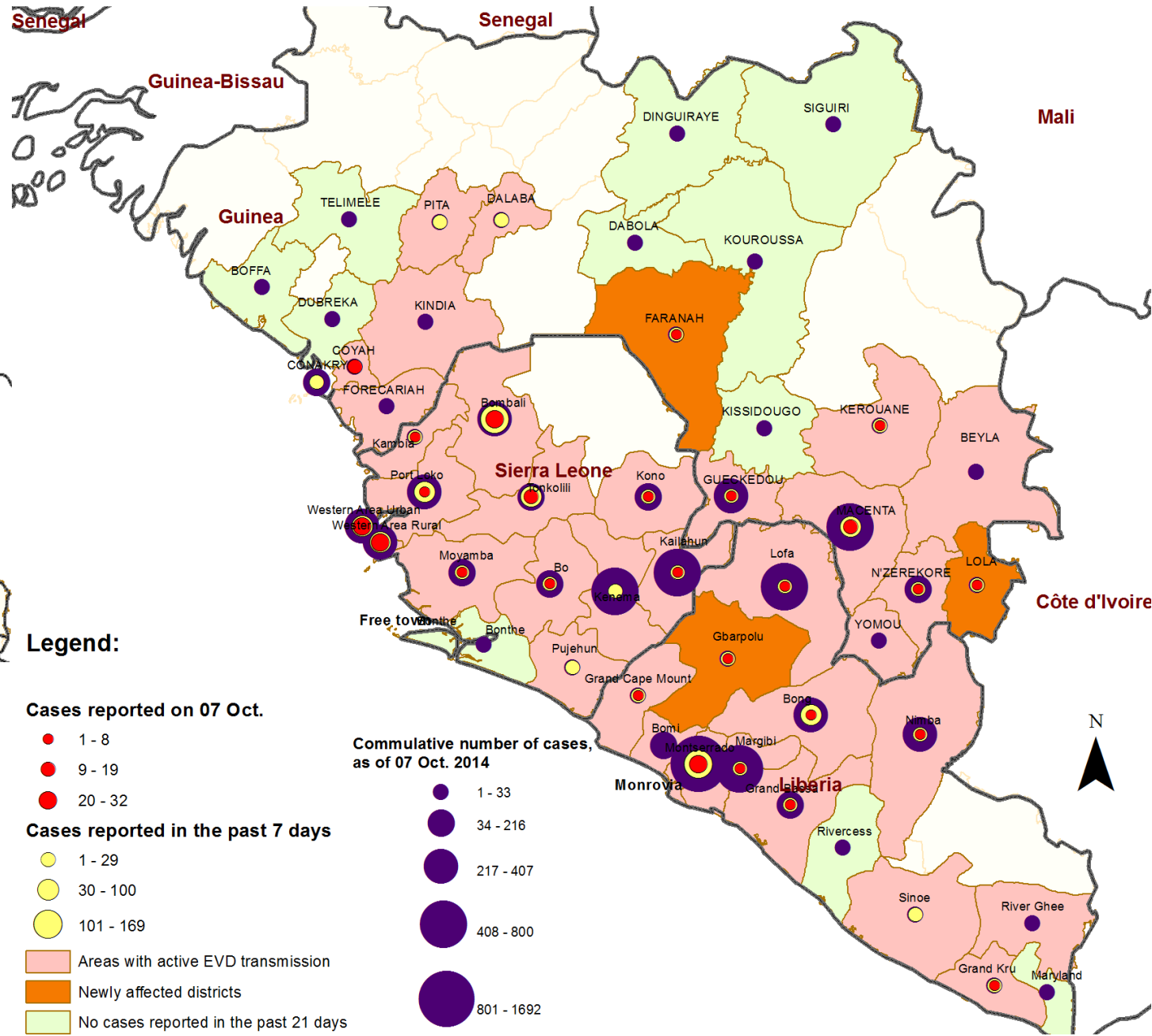
# Ebola Virus Disease in West Africa ( Situation as of 07 October 2014)

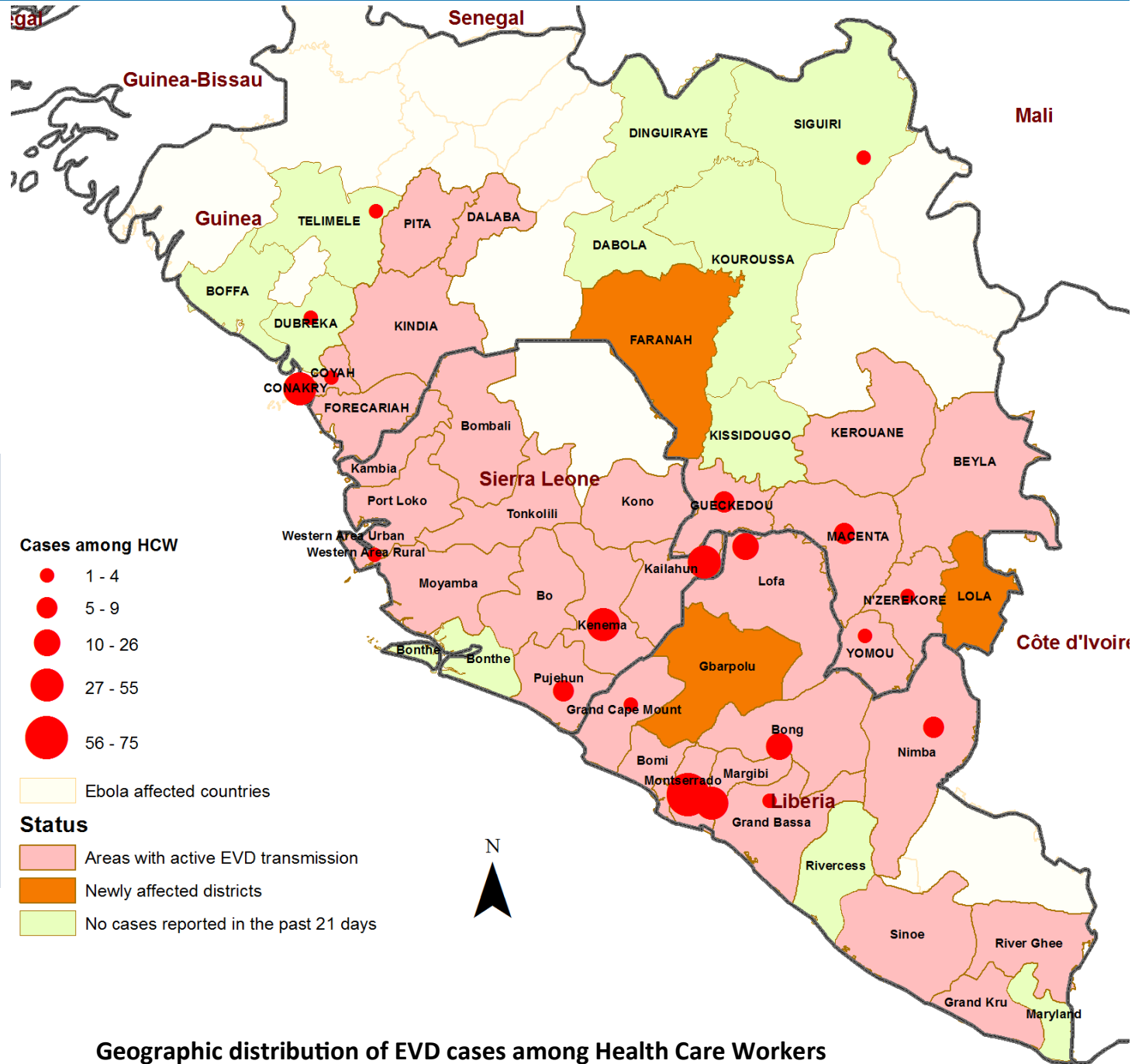
**Geographic distribution of cases of Ebola Virus Disease in West Africa**
