
Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) in the African region (Situation as of 07 October 2014)



- As of 07 October 2014, a total of 8 455 EVD cases including 4 075 deaths reported from six countries (Guinea, Liberia, Sierra Leone, Nigeria, Senegal and DR Congo).
- 220 new cases including44 death reported on 07October 2014.
- The last confirmed cases in Senegal and Nigeria, were reported on 29 August 2014 and 08 September 2014 respectively.



*EVD outbreak in DRC is distinct




