

10 Ways To Bring On That Sizzle That W 0 R K S!


1. Diversity Statement

- Personal/Departmental/Company
- Takes Time To Create
- Stretches You: Makes You Grow




2. Food The Great Equalizer

- Understanding Other Cultures...
 (Indian Weddings, Hanukkah,
 Ramadan, Jehovah's Witness
 Seventh Day Adventist)
- Ramadan
- Rosh Hashannah
- Yom Kippur Day of Atonement
- Hanukkah



3. Deeper Dive Training

- Regular Infusion of Diversity Training
- Brown Bag Lunches Interactive
- Part Of Your Staff Training
- Don't Rely Solely On Online Training
- Once is NOT Enough
- Bring in Outside Expertise
- Do NOT Make It Punitive




4. Use US Postage Stamps

- Makes A Statement That You Care
- A Subtle Way To Act On Diversity
- Company Example: Invitation, Postcards, Special Letters
- Incorporate A Special Lesson With Each Stamp At Your Next Staff Meeting



5. Cover Historical Figures

- Company Trivial Fact Matched By Diversity Fact
- Look For Important Leaders In Your Company or Industry
- Pull In Your Employees To Share Their Suggestions

6. Diversity Calendar

- Create as a Team
- Include ALL Employees and holidays germain to their culture
- Such as Diwali Festival of lights in India
- Print and/or Online Version
- Create special calendars as client gifts




7. Storytelling

- The Power Of Storytelling
- Use storytelling to teach diversity lessons
- Share the stories of others
- Share your family stories
- If speaking, make sure your story relates to the point(s) of your message



8. Go To Their Neighborhood

- Comfort Zone Challenge
- Experience the neighborhoods and homes of your diverse employees, clients, students, colleagues
- Some neighborhoods have historical significance
- Research/read up on the neighborhoods that you visit
- Provide the "space" for discussion back on the job



9. TRAVEL

- Less Than 30% of Americans Own a Passport
- The absolute BEST way to understand diversity and multiculturalism
- Put key locations on your bucket list.
 For me it was India
- WRITE DOWN the places you want to visit
- Put a map on your wall for a visual incentive



10. Create A Town Hall

- The May Institute November 15, 2016
- Nonparisan All Employees Can Attend
- Don't Shy Away From Tough Political Subjects
- Be Inclusive Every Voice Is Welcomed
- Will Be Reassuring...Especially For Green Card, H1B, Immigrant Employees
